

# Summer Studio Courses

Summer Studio courses meet each weekday.

## Morning Sessions:

**Ages 5 - 8** meet 9: 30 am - 11:30 am

## Afternoon Sessions:

**Ages 9 - 13** meet 12:30 am to 2:45 pm

Each week features a different set of projects.

### **Week 1 - Shoestrings & Accordions (July 5, 6, 7) \$65**

“Shoestrings” and “accordions” are types of handmade books. Students will enjoy marbleizing paper, collage, stamping, painting, and drawing to create their own books.

### **Week 2 - Super Sculpture! (July 10 - 14) \$125**

Students will fashion three-dimensional works and learn about various sculpture techniques. They can create with several materials including wire, paper, and recycled items. Art History connections include Robert Indiana, Henry Moore, and Alexander Calder.

### **Week 3 - Paint Lab (July 17 - 21) \$125**

Lab is all about an adventure in painting and mixed media. We will look at what is being done by some contemporary artists and try some of their techniques. These engaging projects are sure to enhance every child’s creativity and confidence.

### **Week 4 - Kaleidoscope of Colors (July 24 - 28) \$125**

The world is full of beautiful colors! Students will learn how color has been used by some of our favorite artists. They will create art with a variety of media including patterned papers, markers, paints, and pastels.

### **Week 5 - Words & Pictures (July 31 - Aug. 4) \$125**

Students will explore how pictures and words relate to each other. Drawing, painting, collage, and printmaking projects will connect to literature and graphic design.

### **Week 6 - Mix it Up! (August 7 - 11) \$125**

Students will be able to choose from a variety of projects as well as explore various media including 3-dimensional work. They will have the opportunity to further develop their artistic skills.

## Adventures in Modern

This course introduces students to several works of art from the early twentieth century to today. Projects will involve painting, sculpture, printmaking, and collage. Students can become Impressionists, Pop artists, and more.
